

**AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO ORDINANCE NO. 2014-2  
TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION ORDINANCE  
OF

**DELETE:**

Article V - Exemption of livestock, grains, and agricultural products from taxation.

- 5.1 Farm animals and livestock and grains and agricultural products are hereby defined as separate items of taxation and classified as follows:
- (h) Farm machinery and implements designed solely for the planting, production or harvesting of a single product or commodity including farm tractors, farm utility vehicles as defined in 46.2 — 100 of the Code of Virginia.

**ADD:**

Article V - Exemption of livestock, grains, and agricultural products from taxation.

- 5.1 Farm animals and livestock and grains and agricultural products are hereby defined as separate items of taxation and classified as follows:
- (h) Farm machinery and implements, including farm tractors and farm utility vehicles as defined by Section 46.2 – 100 of the Code of Virginia, designed solely for the planting, production or harvesting of a single product or commodity, including forest harvesting and silviculture activities.
