

**AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 91-5
ANIMAL AND FOWL ORDINANCE
WYTHE COUNTY, VIRGINIA**

A public hearing was held on Tuesday, April 27, 1993, at 7:15 p.m. in the Town of Rural Retreat's Community Center, Rural Retreat, Virginia, to consider adding an amendment to Ordinance No. 91-5, "ANIMAL AND FOWL ORDINANCE", as follows:

Delete:

6.1 Dogs running at large of Article VI.

Add:

6.1 Dogs running at large. It shall be unlawful for any person in the county to permit a dog owned by him, or by his minor children, or the custodian of a dog, or an astray dog permitted to stay principally on premises occupied by him to run at large. A dog shall be deemed to run at large while roaming, running, or self-hunting off the property of its owner or custodian and not under its owner's or custodian's immediate control. Any person who permits his dog to run at large, or remain unconfined, unrestricted, or not penned up shall be deemed to have violated the provisions of this section. The provision of this section shall apply to the Town of Rural Retreat and the unincorporated areas of Wythe County.

Supervisor Davis made a motion to approve this amendment. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Crosswell and the roll call vote is as follows:
