

ORDINANCE NO.

**AN ORDINANCE DISCONTINUING AND VACATING A PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY
LOCATED BETWEEN LOTS 74-3-11 & 12 AND 74-3-17, 18 & 18A NEAR
AUSTINVILLE ROAD IN THE LEAD MINES MAGISTERIAL DISTRICT, WYTHE
COUNTY, VIRGINIA**

WHEREAS, Gary Delby and Julie White have submitted an application to vacate a public right-of-way located between Lots 74-3-11 & 12 and 74-3-17, 18 & 18A located near Austinville Road in the Lead Mines Magisterial District, Wythe County, Virginia.

WHEREAS, notice that the Board of Supervisors of Wythe County would consider such request has been given pursuant to Section 15.2-2006 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors held a public meeting and considered such application on June 12, 2018, pursuant to such notice.

WHEREAS, the Board was of the opinion that the vacation would not result in any inconvenience and was in the interest of public welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained that the forty (40) foot public right-of-way between Lots 74-3-11 & 12 and 74-3-17, 18 & 18A that is shown on the tax map (area vacated highlighted) that is attached to this ordinance and is hereby made a part of this ordinance by reference, in the Lead Mines Magisterial District, Wythe County, Virginia, is hereby discontinued and vacated.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance be recorded as deeds are recorded and indexed, in the name of the County of Wythe, in the Clerk's Office of the Circuit Court of Wythe County, Virginia.

This ordinance was duly considered following a required public hearing held on June 12, 2018, and was adopted by the Board of Supervisors of Wythe County, Virginia, at its regular meeting held on June 12, 2018, the members voting:
